DAY 02

WELCOME TO ISRAEL

Thurs 2 / 25

You will land at Ben Gurion International Airport just outside of Tel Aviv and be welcomed by our airport representative.

Dinner and overnight at the Daniel Herzliya Hotel in Herzliya.

DAY 03 Fri 2/26 CAESAREA, MEGIDDO, SEA OF GALILEE, MOUNT CARMEL, NAZARETH

Heading north to the Sea of Galilee, we will enjoy a scenic drive along the beautiful coast of the Mediterranean Sea to **Caesarea Maritima**, which was the center of early Christians where Cornelius became the first Gentile convert (Acts 10) and Paul was imprisoned before being taken to Rome. We will stop at **Mt. Carmel (Muhraka)** for an overview of the site where Elijah held the triumphal contest with 450 prophets of Baal. Continue to **Megiddo** to see the remains dating to Solomon's days and view the place where the Battle of Armageddon will be fought. Visit Jesus's childhood home of Nazareth and visit **Nazareth Village**. We will continue to Tiberias and check in to our hotel.

Dinner and overnight at the Leonardo Plaza, Sea of Galilee.

DAY 04 Sat 2/27 CAPERNAUM, MT of BEATITUDES, TABGHA, BOAT RIDE, JESUS BOAT

Spend the day literally in His footsteps. Explore **Capernaum**, visit the ancient synagogue where Jesus taught, and see St. Peter's house. Visit **Tabgha** (the site of Peter's Primacy),





where Jesus fed the 5,000. Continue for meditation at the Mt. of Beatitudes. We will visit the ancient 2,000 year-old "Jesus Boat," learn about its fascinating restoration, and enjoy a memorable boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. Optional: We will end our day at Magdala, recently excavated along the shores of the Galilee, where an ancient synagogue and the oldest known menorah inscription from the Second Temple period were discovered.

Dinner & overnight at the Leonardo Plaza Sea of Galilee.

DAY 05 Sun 2/28

UPPER GALILEE, GOLAN HEIGHTS

Today we travel through the upper Galilee and the Golan. Drive to **Tel Dan** to see the Laish city gate that dates to Abraham's time. We will take the beautiful Dan Nature Preserve Walk. Visit **Caesarea Philippi** where Peter made his great confession and see the head waters that form the Jordan River and visit a waterfall. We will conclude our day with **baptisms on the Jordan river**.

Dinner & overnight at the Leonardo Plaza Sea of Galilee.

DAY 06 Mon 3/01

HAROD'S SPRING, JORDAN VALLEY, QUMRAN

Today we depart the Sea Of Galilee area and drive south, with our first stop at Gideon's Spring. Visit Beit-Shean/Scythopolis, one of Israel's most magnificent archeological sites, strategically located at the juncture of the Jezreel and Jordan Valleys. After defeating Saul and his sons on Mt. Gilboa, the Philistines hanged their bodies on the walls of Beit-Shean (1 Sam 31:10-12). During the intertestamental period, the city was renamed "Scythopolis," and archaeologists have uncovered extensive Roman and Byzantine ruins. During the time of Jesus, Scythopolis was a leading city of the Decapolis, a league of ten cities sharing Greek culture and governance. Then we will drive by Jericho and view the Mt. of Temptations, before visiting Qumran, where the Dead Sea scrolls were discovered. Continue to a hotel on the **Dead** Sea and enjoy some time at leisure to swim in the healing waters.

Dinner and overnight at the Nevo Hotel.







DAY 07 Tues

3/02

MASADA, EIN GEDI

Explore Masada and take a cable car to the summit to explore a fortress built by King Herod, which later became the last stronghold of the Jewish rebellion against the Romans. Next we will stop at Ein Gedi, where a short walk through the nature reserve leads to the hidden David's Falls, where David once hid from Saul. We will stop for a view of Wadi Kelt and St. George's Monastery before ascending to Jerusalem, the Holy City of Gold. We will stop for a prayer and a panoramic view before checking into our hotel. Dinner and overnight at the Leonardo Hotel, Jerusalem.

DAY 08 Wed 3/03

VIA DOLOROSA, POOL OF BETHESDA, GARDEN TOMB

Experience ancient Jerusalem. Enter the old city through the Lions' Gate and walk down the Via Dolorosa. Along the route, visit the Church of St. Anne and the Pool of Bethesda. We will stop at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. We will conclude our time together as we view Golgotha above the beautiful Garden Tomb. Here we will enjoy a time of communion, praise, worship, and testimony.

Optional: In the afternoon we will visit the **Western Wall tunnels** and enjoy time at leisure.

Dinner and overnight at the Leonardo Hotel, Jerusalem.

DAY 09 Thurs 3/04

SHEPHERDS' FIELD & ISRAEL MUSEUM

We will begin our day with a visit to **Shepherds' Field**, just outside Bethlehem in Beit Sahour, traditionally believed to be where angels announced the birth of Jesus to shepherds keeping watch over their flocks. The site features beautiful chapels—both Catholic and Greek Orthodox—set amid peaceful fields and caves that evoke the biblical scene of the Nativity. We will then continue to the **Israel Museum** in Jerusalem, the country's premier cultural institution and one of the world's leading art and archaeology museums. There we will visit the Shrine of the Book, to view the ancient Dead Sea Scrolls. We will also explore the outdoor model of Second Temple—period Jerusalem, which offers a vivid glimpse into the city's ancient past. Enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure. Optional tour to the ancient **City of David**.

Dinner and overnight at the Leonardo Hotel, Jerusalem.







DAY 10 Fri 3/05

MOUNT OF OLIVES, PALM SUNDAY ROAD, GETHSEMENE

Begin today at the **Mount of Olives** to view the Old City of Jerusalem. Walk down the **Palm Sunday Road** to the **Garden of Gethsemane** to pray and see the olive trees Jesus wept on the night of His betrayal. (**Optional:** City of David tour, including the Pool of Siloam.) We will then continue to the **Western Wall**, the holiest site in Judaism, where visitors can place prayers into the ancient stones. The remainder of the day will be at leisure.

Dinner and overnight at the Leonardo Hotel, Jerusalem.

DAY 11

DEPARTURE

Transfer to Ben Gurion Airport to board our flight to the USA.
